### ChipMOS REPORTS SEPTEMBER 2005 REVENUE

**Hsinchu, Taiwan, October 19, 2005** ChipMOS TECHNOLOGIES (Bermuda) LTD. ( ChipMOS or the Company ) (Nasdaq: IMOS) today reported its unaudited consolidated revenue for the month of September 2005.

Revenue for the month of September 2005 was NT\$1,343.5 million or US\$40.5 million, an increase of 5% from NT\$1,277.8 million or US\$38.5 million for the month of August 2005 and an increase of 2% from NT\$1,322.0 million or US\$39.8 million for the same period in 2004. (All translations from NT dollars to U.S. dollars were made at the exchange rate of NT\$33.18 against US\$1.00 as of September 30, 2005.)
