Starboard Value LP acts as the investment manager of Starboard V&O Fund and Starboard Value LP Account and as the manager of Starboard LLC. Starboard Value LP has sole voting and dispositive power over the shares held by the Starboard Value LP Account. Starboard Value GP LLC ("Starboard Value GP") serves as the general partner of Starboard Value LP. Starboard Principal Co GP LLC ("Principal Co") is a member of Starboard Value GP.

The Reporting Person serves as a member of Principal GP and a member of each of the Management Committee of Starboard Value GP and the Management Committee of Principal GP.
