**NOTICE TO THE MARKET**

**ARACRUZ CELULOSE S.A.** ("**Aracruz**" or the "**company**") announces that it has learned, through a press release issued yesterday in the U.S.A., that the law firm **Saxena White P.A.**, based in Boca Raton, Florida, has filed a Class Action against the **company** in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida. According to the aforementioned release, this Class Action has been undertaken in the name of the **company**'s shareholders who acquired American Depositary Receipts ("ADRs") and/or shares issued by **Aracruz** during the period April 7<sup>th</sup> to October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2008.

Also according to the abovementioned press release, the purpose of the Class Action is to obtain indemnification for losses arising from the alleged violation of U.S. capital market regulations, as a result of the foreign exchange derivative transactions carried out by the **company**.

**Aracruz** has not been officially notified of this Class Action, but as soon as the company has any further information it will provide due clarification to the market and the regulatory authorities.
