(1) Shares withheld to cover taxes in connection with the vesting on November 15, 2008 of the restricted stock units awarded on August 15, 2008.

(2) Shares awarded pursuant to the vesting of performance share units. Vesting of the performance share units was based on the Company meeting certain operating targets. The Compensation Committee determined that one of these targets had been met and the issuance of the 27,500 underlying shares was authorized, effective February 15, 2009. One-third of the shares were immediately vested with the remaining 18,333 shares vesting in two equal annual installments beginning on February 15, 2010.

(3) Includes 1,346 shares withheld to cover taxes in connection with the vesting on February 15, 2009 of the restricted stock units awarded on August 15, 2008 and 3,488 shares withheld to cover taxes in connection with the vesting on February 15, 2009 of the performance share units awarded on August 15, 2008.
