Item 8.01. Other Events

On June 27, 2014, India Globalization Capital, Inc. (“IGC”) entered into an agreement with TerraSphere Systems, LLC and Greenlife Ventures, Inc. to develop multiple facilities to produce organic leafy green vegetables utilizing TerraSphere’s advanced pesticide-free organic indoor farming technology. Under the agreement, IGC will own 51% of each venture once production is operational, and will have a right of first refusal to participate in all future build-outs. IGC is required to make an investment in cash in the venture within 60 days after the date of agreement and, in consideration for IGC’s issuance of 50,000 shares of its common stock, IGC received a seven-year option to purchase the venture for cash or additional shares of its common stock. The issuance of the shares was exempt from registration pursuant to Section 4(a)(2) of the Securities Act of 1933, as not involving any public offering. A copy of the press release is attached as Exhibit 99.1 to this current report on Form 8-K.
