(TELMEX) (BMV: TELMEX; NYSE: TMX; NASDAQ: TFOY; LATIBEX: XTMXL) announced today that its Board of Directors at a meeting held on November 9, 2005, authorized to submit a proposal to the Ordinary Shareholders Meeting to increase 10 billion Mexican pesos the funds to purchase its own shares. The Ordinary Shareholders Meeting will be held on November 28, 2005.
